Business Arising from the minutes:

- Greg will get Derek Salsman down to the park to discuss where the new lights should be.
- Greg rolled out his report on paving for the park. Quote provided by Angus at Lefarge.
- Les and Greg to check into cost of paving provided by Lefarge. Donation to the village?
- Steve Dalziel recommended finding out the cost of sand seal, and comparing it to the paving. Greg to get a quote from Angus at Lefarge.
- Greg suggests that until we get the plans back from Hiltz and Seamone, we should leave the fence on the Miller Diamond where it is. Deal with it at that time.
- Use existing signs to label the new fields. Greg will have these cut up and used.
- Flag poles at the Civic Centre. Les suggested that we have flag poles that come out from the centre on a slant. Greg to find out the price on this.
- Painting of the Civic Centre. The quote is \$3800. Les suggested that it be done in the spring and the recreation staff to do it. This will come out of the village budget.
- Get details from Linda as to what is in the fund. The fund is \$28,800.
- We should not purchase the "Bishop" land (across from old View and Chew) we should just maintain it. Add a garbage can.
